




Google Authenticator Instructions

1. Install **Google Authenticator app** on your phone. **Log in** to Digital Banking from your desktop and select **"Security"** tab on your profile.

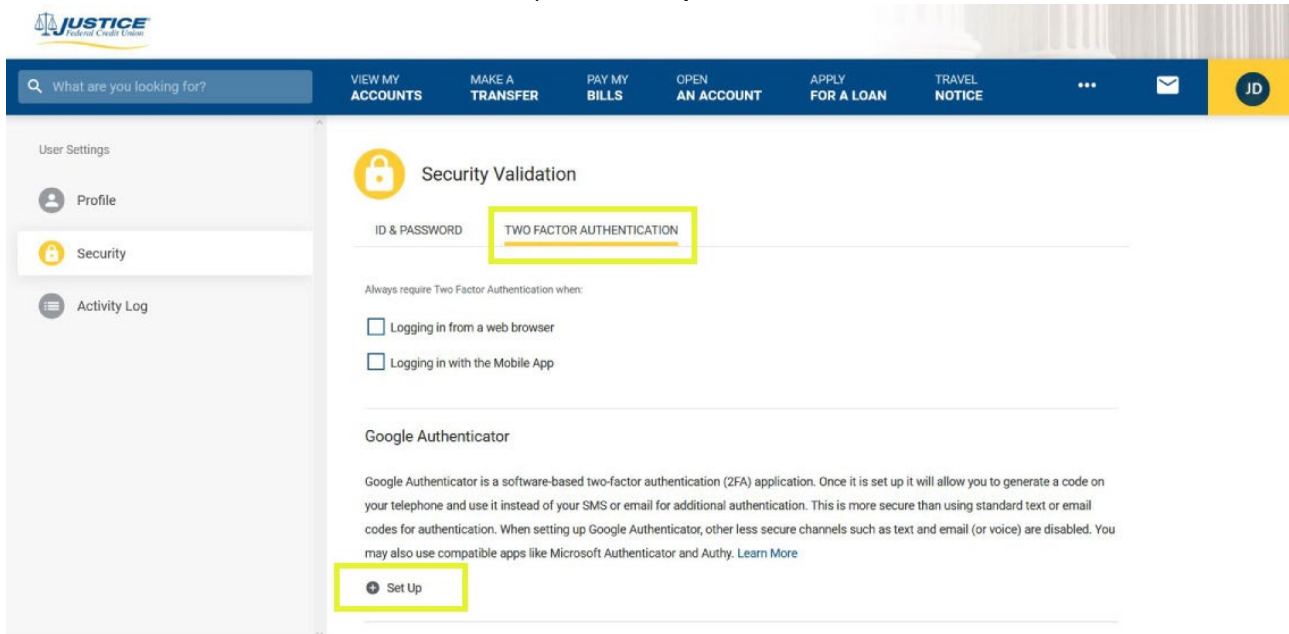

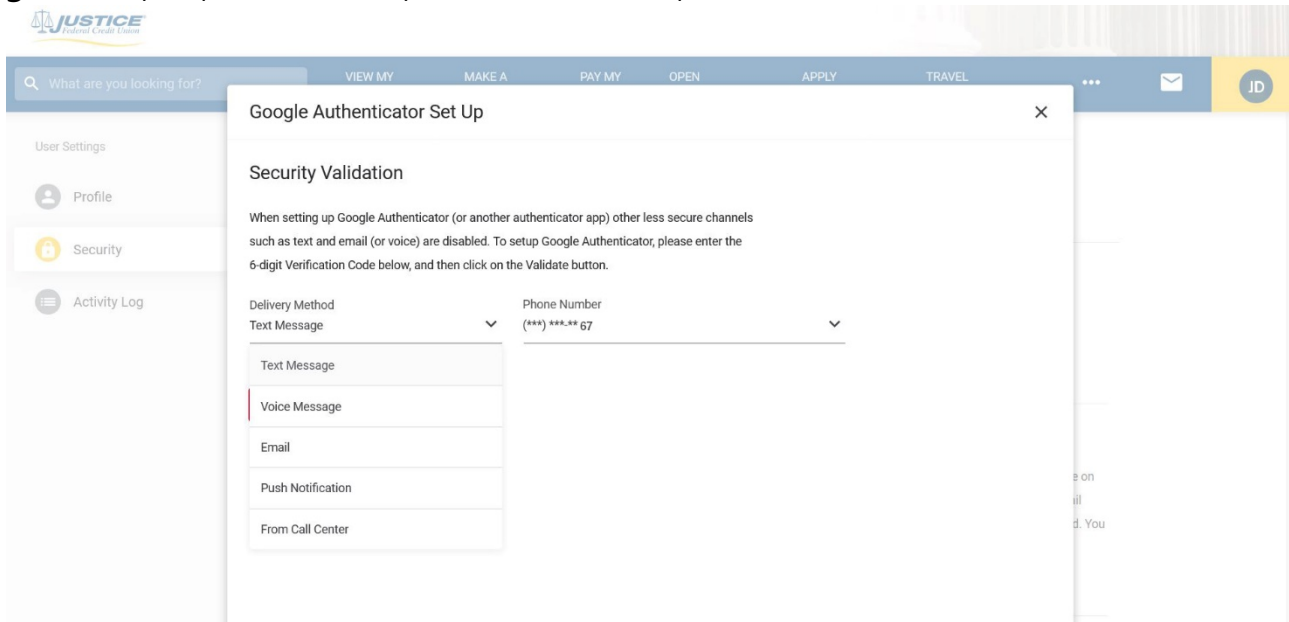

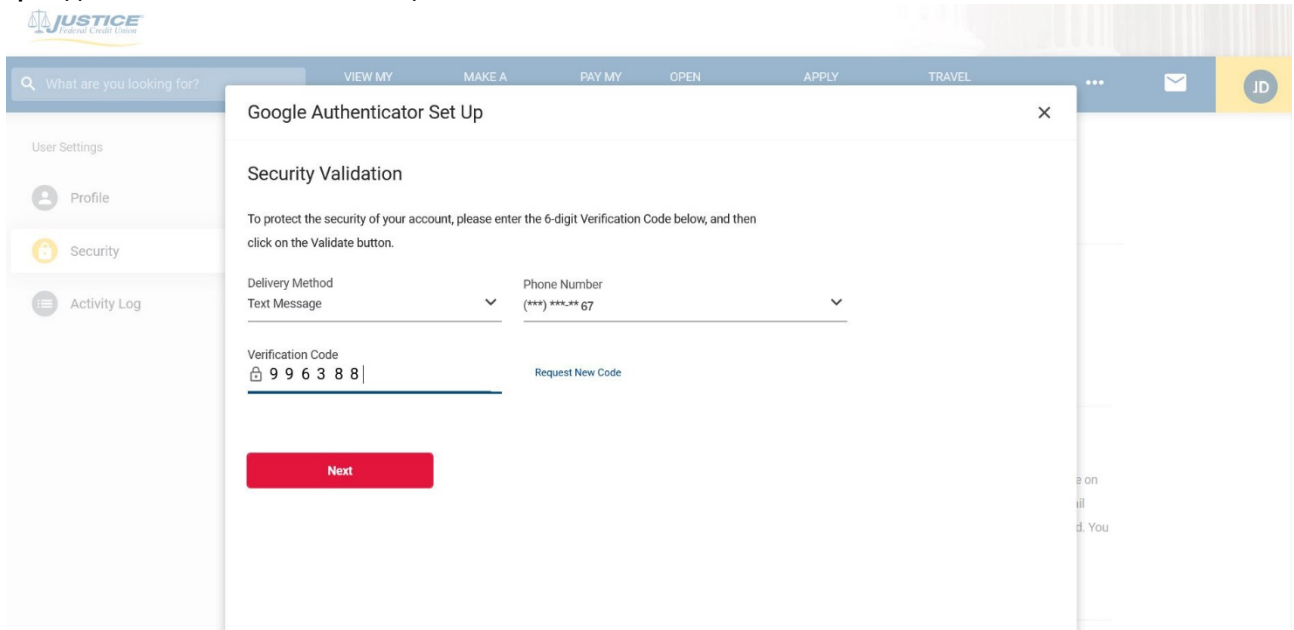
2. Select "Two Factor Authentication" and press "Set Up".



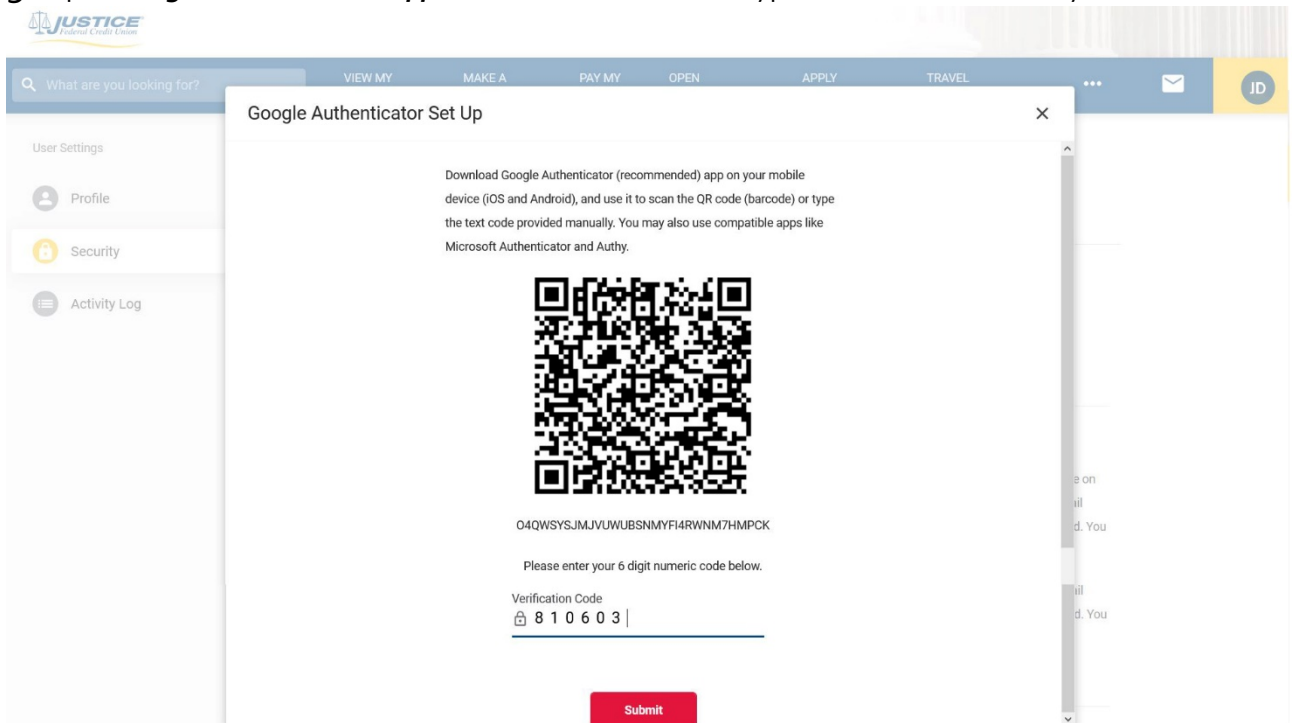
3. Choose your preferred delivery method from the drop-down.

5. Open **Google Authenticator app** and scan the **QR code** or type the text code manually.




6. Choose your settings for future logins from desktop and phone. Press **"Save"**.
